

5. The promises of the parties herein contained shall be deemed to be covenants running with the land and shall inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors, and assigns.

6. That this agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and shall be binding on all signatories hereto in the same force and effect as though all parties had executed one counterpart.
