Optionee, in exercising its rights hereunder, shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, creed, color or national origin, and a provision identical with the foregoing shall be included in all contracts made by Optionee relating to the exercise of Optionee's rights hereunder.

8. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.

9. It is further agreed:
