Reference is made to your letter of March 29, 1955, pertaining to the above described tract. At present there is no production on the above described lease, and we would have no objection to dealing the net interest owned by Western Oil Refining Company in said tract.

The ownership of Western Oil Refining Company is, first of all, limited to the "Shallow Zones," those oil and gas horizons lying above 1500 feet above the first appearance of the Frontier Formation, and our ownership is further restricted by already existing overrides and oil payments as detailed below:
