and Jeanetta E. Fear, husband and wife,

, as Lessor,

and GENERAL PETROLEUM CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation, as Lessee, which lease was recorded May 11, 1954, in Book 8, Page 277,

Official Records of Sublette County, Wyoming, together with all of its right, title and interest in and to the said leasehold estate insofar only as said leasehold estate affects the portion of the leased lands herein surrendered and quitclaimed, which is all of said leased lands other than that portion hereinabove specifically described.
