REASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:


THAT, WHEREAS, by an Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease, dated June 14, 1953, recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sublette County, Wyoming, in Book 7 of Oil and Gas Leases, Page 198 of Official Records, hereinafter referred to as "said assignment", CITIES SERVICE OIL COMPANY, a corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Cities Service", assigned unto RICHFIELD OIL CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Richfield", an undivided one-half (1/2) of its right, title and interest in and to that certain Oil and Gas Lease dated April 1, 1952, recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sublette County, Wyoming, in Book 4 of Oil and Gas Leases, Page 169 of Official Records, hereinafter referred to as "said lease", between BATTLE MOUNTAIN RANCH, a Wyoming corporation, as Lessor, and Cities Service, as Lessee, covering certain land situate in said County and State, and particularly described in said lease, reference to said lease and to said assignment being hereby made for further particulars: and

WHEREAS, Richfield, pursuant to the terms of said lease and of said assignment, has elected to reassign all of its right, title and interest in said lease to Cities Service:

NOW, THEREFORE, Richfield, in exercise of the rights granted in said lease and in said assignment does hereby reassign, transfer and set over unto Cities Service and to its successors and assigns, as they may be entitled thereto, all of its right, title and interest in and to the said lease and in and to the leasehold estate created thereby.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Richfield has caused its corporate name to be hereunto subscribed and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed by its proper officers thereunto duly authorized, this 27th day of December, 1955.
