

This is notice to each and all of you that C. I. Justheim (Clarence I. Justheim) and J. H. Morgan (John H. Morgan, Sr.) claim that pursuant to the assignments hereinbefore referred to that from the shallow zone they are entitled to a five per cent (5%) of the one-eighth (1/8) (twelve and one-half percent (12½%)) overriding royalty reserved by Howell in the Assignment of February 21, 1952. That pursuant to paragraph 3 of the Assignment of February 21, 1952 the undersigned are to receive one and one-half per cent (1½%) overriding royalty on all oil and/or gas or other hydrocarbons produced and sold in the deep zone. That pursuant to paragraph 4 of the Assignment of February 21, 1952 the gas in the shallow zone is to be purchased at a sum of 3.2¢ per 1,000 cu. ft. and that the gas in the deep zone is to be purchased at 6¢ per 1,000 cu. ft., except as to the government royalty gas.


