

SURRENDER OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of March, 1952, a certain oil and gas lease was made and entered into between Jensen Land & Livestock Company, a corporation, as Lessor, and A. G. McClintock, as Lessee, covering the following described lands in the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming:

T. 31 N., R. 109 W., 6th P.M.

Sec. 10: NE/4SE/4, S/2SE/4;
 Sec. 11: Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, W/2NE/4,
 S/2NW/4, NW/4SW/4;
 Sec. 14: Lots 1, 2, NE/4NW/4;
 Sec. 15: Lots 1, 2;

Also all the bed of the New Fork River between mean high water and medial lines thereof, in front of and appurtenant to Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, Section 11, Lots 1 and 2, Section 14, and Lots 1 and 2, Section 15, T. 31 N., R. 109 W., 6th P.M.;

which lease has been recorded and now appears of record in Book 5 of Oil and Gas Leases, on page 98 of the books and records in the office of the County Clerk of Sublette County, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, by assignment dated June 26, 1953, and correction assignment dated October 22, 1953, the said A. G. McClintock, joined by his wife, Jean R. McClintock, only for the purposes of releasing and waiving her homestead rights, if any, in the said lands and lease, assigned all of his right, title and interest in said lease to Forest Oil Corporation, in which assignment there was reserved to the said A. G. McClintock an overriding royalty of three percent (3%) and a production payment of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per net mineral acre of productive lands payable out of eight percent (8%) of the production from said leased lands; and

WHEREAS, under date of December 17, 1957, said Forest Oil Corporation reassigned said lease to A. G. McClintock, which said reassignment is filed for recording herewith; and
