

1 (f) To install and maintain cattle guards to prevent the
2 passage of livestock in any openings made in fences by the
3 Unit Operator or its contractors to provide access to the
4 lands covered by this unit agreement for automotive and other
5 equipment.

6 (g) If Unit Operator shall construct any camp on the land,
7 such camp shall be located at a place approved by the authorized
8 representative of the Secretary of Agriculture, and such
9 representative shall have authority to require that such camp
10 be kept in a neat and sanitary condition.

11 (h) To comply with all the rules and regulations of the
12 Secretary of Agriculture governing the national forests or
13 other lands under his jurisdiction which are embraced in this
14 unit area.

15 (i) Unless otherwise authorized, prior to the beginning of
16 operations to appoint and maintain at all times during the term
17 of this unit agreement a local agent upon whom may be served
18 written orders or notices respecting matters contained in this
19 stipulation, and to inform the authorized representative of the
20 Secretary of Agriculture, in writing, of the name and address
21 of such agent. If a substitute agent is appointed, the Unit
22 Operator shall immediately so inform the said representative.

23 (j) To address all matters relating to this stipulation to
24 Regional Forester, Dept. of Agriculture, Forest Service,
25 Intermountain Region, Forest Service Bldg., Ogden, Utah,
26 who is the authorized representative of the Secretary of
27 Agriculture, or to such other representative as may from time
28 to time, be designated, provided that such designation shall
29 be in writing and be delivered to the Unit Operator or its agent.

30 (k) If all or any parts of the unit area lie within a municipal
31 watershed, or are, in the opinion of the authorized represent-
32 ative of the Secretary of Agriculture, primarily valuable for
