2 (e) Any Federal lease for a fixed term of twenty (20) 2  
3 years or any renewal thereof or any part of such lease which 3  
4 is made subject to this agreement shall continue in force 4  
5 beyond the term provided therein until the termination 5  
6 hereof. Any other Federal lease committed hereto shall 6  
7 continue in force beyond the term so provided therein or 7  
8 by law as to the land committed so long as such lease 8  
9 remains subject hereto, provided that production is had 9  
10 in paying quantities under this unit agreement prior to 10  
11 the expiration date of the term of such lease. 11

12 (f) Each sublease or contract relating to the opera- 12  
13 tion and development of unitized substances from lands of 13  
14 the United States committed to this agreement, which by 14  
15 its terms would expire prior to the time at which the 15  
16 underlying lease, as extended by the immediately preced- 16  
17 ing paragraph, will expire, is hereby extended beyond any 17  
18 such term so provided therein so that it shall be continued 18  
19 in full force and effect for and during the term of the 19  
20 underlying lease as such term is herein extended. 20

21 (g) The segregation of any Federal lease committed 21  
22 to this agreement is governed by the following provision 22  
23 in the fourth paragraph of Sec. 17(b) of the Act, as 23  
24 amended by the Act of July 29, 1954 (68 Stat. 583, 585): 24  
25 "Any [Federal] lease hereafter committed to any such [unit] 25  
26 plan embracing lands that are in part within and in part 26  
27 outside of the area covered by any such plan shall be 27  
28 segregated into separate leases as to the lands committed 28  
29 and the lands not committed as of the effective date of 29  
30 unitization: Provided, however, That any such lease as 30  
31 to the nonunitized portion shall continue in force and 31  
32 effect for the term thereof but for not less than two 32
