

ARTICLE VI - PRICE

1. Subject to the adjustment for heating value, as provided in Section 3 of this article, the price to be paid by Buyer for each one thousand (1000) cubic feet of gas delivered hereunder to Buyer shall be fifteen cents (15¢); on the fifth anniversary of delivery of gas under this contract such price shall be increased one cent (1¢) a thousand cubic feet; on the tenth anniversary of delivery of gas hereunder, the price shall be increased an additional one cent (1¢) a thousand cubic feet; on the fifteenth anniversary of delivery of gas hereunder, the price shall be advanced an additional one cent (1¢) a thousand cubic feet.

2. If at any time or times, subsequent to the date of the execution of this contract, Buyer shall enter into a contract with a gas producer providing for the purchase by it of gas produced from a field or fields in Lincoln, Sublette, Fremont, Sweetwater and Uinta counties, Wyoming; Moffat, Routt, Rio Blanco counties, Colorado; and Daggett, Duchesne and Uintah counties, Utah, and delivered to Buyer, and such contract provides a higher price than the price payable hereunder during the same contract year, then Buyer will increase the price payable to Seller for gas delivered hereunder by an amount equal to the difference between the higher price paid at the time by Buyer to any such other gas producer and the price payable hereunder. In determining whether the price payable under such other contract is higher than the price payable
