NEVERTHELESS, there is not conveyed hereby, but there is expressly reserved to the said Frances K. Kellogg, her heirs and assigns, as a free overriding royalty, the value of one and three-fourths per cent ($1\frac{3}{4}\%$) of all oil and gas which shall be produced, saved and marketed under the terms of said oil and gas lease and any extension thereof.
