AGREEMENT PERMITTING COMMINGLING

Whereas, Pan American Petroleum Corporation and Belco Petroleum Corporation, corporations authorized to do business in the State of Wyoming, said parties hereinafter sometimes being referred to as "Pan American" and "Belco", respectively, are the owners of all the operating rights and working interests in and to the "Mesaverde Reservoir", defined as being that reservoir contained in the sands and associated overlying conglomerates which contribute to the production of oil and associated gas from Belco B-54 well located in the SE/4 SE/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 29 North, Range 113 West, 6th P.M., from the depth intervals of 3216 feet to 3721 feet, in and to the following described oil and gas leases insofar as such leases cover the lands hereinafter described in the separate designation of said leases, said lands being situated in Sublette County, Wyoming:
