GRANT OF EASEMENT FOR NATURAL GAS PIPELINE

EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Board of Land Commissioners of the State of Wyoming, acting within the authority vested in it by and under the Constitution of the State of Wyoming and the Wyoming Compiled Statutes, doth, for and in consideration of the payment of FIFTY AND 00/100 DOLLARS

(\$ 50.00) grant to EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY

for the uses and purposes and upon the conditions hereinafter set forth, an easement for NATURAL GAS PIPELINE

over a certain tract of land more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land for a Natural Gas Pipeline Seventy-five feet (75') in width, being Thirty-seven and One-half feet ($37\frac{1}{2}$) on each side of a centerline across the East Half Southeast Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section Thirty-six (36), Township Twenty-seven (27) North, Range One Hundred Fourteen (114) West of the 6th P. M. in Sublette County, Wyoming; being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East boundary of said Section 36, which point bears in a Northerly direction along the East boundary of said Section 36, distant 351.5 feet from the southeast corner of said Section 36; thence North 24° 42' West a distance of 1647.4 feet to the end of the line crossing land owned by the State of Wyoming, which point bears North 24° 53' West, distant 1964.6 feet from the southeast corner of said Section 36.
