18. FAIR EMPLOYMENT

General shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, creed, color or national origin, and shall require an identical provision to be included in all sub-contracts.

19. The parties hereto hereby consent as to the lands of the United States, to a reservation to the United States, pursuant to the provisions of the Act of August 1, 1946 (Public No. 585, 79th Congress) of all uranium, thorium and other materials which are or may be determined to be peculiarly essential to the production of fissionable materials, whether or not of commercial value, together with the right of the United States, through its authorized agents or representatives, at any time to enter upon the land and prospect for, mine and remove same.
