

RECEIPT AND RATIFICATION

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 22nd day of April, 1963, by and between Ruth A. Chamberlain, ^{a widow of} La Barge, Wyoming, hereinafter called First Party, and Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., P. O. Box 1652, Casper, Wyoming, hereinafter called Second Party.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Second Party is the owner of certain operating rights, and working interest under Oil and Gas Lease dated January 17, 1950, by and between William O. Chamberlain and Ruth A. Chamberlain lessor(s), and Western Oil Refining Company, lessee, recorded February 8, 1950, in Book 2 of Oil and Gas Leases at Page 295 of the Records of Sublette County, Wyoming. Said lease covers the following described lands in said County and State:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) and the payments heretofore made, as hereinafter set forth, and other good and sufficient consideration in hand paid to First Party by Second Party, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby expressly acknowledged by First Party, the parties agree as follows:

1. First Party does hereby ratify and confirm the said above described oil and gas lease as being in full force and effect in accordance with its terms and First Party acknowledges the timely payment and receipt in full of all payments and delay rentals heretofore payable to First Party under the provisions of the said oil and gas lease.

2. For the purpose of recognizing and acknowledging the validity of the said lease, First Party does further grant, lease and let the above described lands in accordance with the terms and provisions of the said above described lease, to the full extent of First Party's right, title and interest in and to the oil, gas and other minerals which may be found on or underlying said lands.
