

so that said aggregate does not exceed seventeen and one-half percent (17½%) when the average production per well per day, averaged on a monthly basis, is as to oil, fifteen (15) barrels or less. This limitation shall apply separately to any zone or portion of a lease segregated for computing government or state royalty.

This assignment is subject to the terms and provisions of said leases and to the approval, where applicable, of the Secretary of the Interior or his duly authorized representatives and the Wyoming State Land Board and to the applicable statutes, rules and regulations of any governmental authority having jurisdiction. It is understood that this assignment must be filed with the Wyoming State Land Board and with the Bureau of Land Management within ninety (90) days from the date of execution and Assignee agrees to promptly file the same at his own cost and expense.

All of the provisions hereof shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, successors, personal representatives, and assigns of the respective parties hereto. Assignee, by his acceptance and filing or recording hereof, agrees to be bound by the terms and provisions of this assignment.

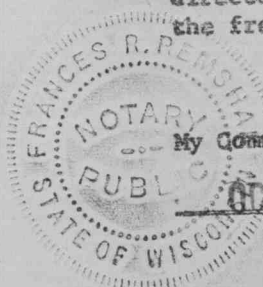
