Campbell, as lessee, or any extension or renewal thereof, or allocated to said above-described land under the terms and provisions of the Unit Agreement for the Hogsback Unit Area, Counties of Sublette and Lincoln, State of Wyoming, of date November 1, 1954, bearing I-Sec. No. 14-08-001-2070, approved by the United States Geological Survey on May 27, 1955, hereinafter called "Unit Agreement," or the Unit Operating Agreement of date September 1, 1957, by and between General Petroleum Corporation, Phillips Petroleum Company, and Belfer Natural Gas Company, as amended, hereinafter called "Unit Operating Agreement," which said overriding royalty is four-fifths of the five per cent (5%) overriding royalty reserved by Betty Jane Miller in the Assignment Affecting Record Title to Oil and Gas Lease of date September 10, 1957, from Betty Jane Miller to John R. Moran.
