

1 contrary in any lease, operating agreement or other contract by and between the 1
 2 parties hereto, or their respective predecessors in interest, or any of them. 2

3 (b) Drilling and producing operations performed hereunder upon any tract 3
 4 of unitized lands will be accepted and deemed to be performed upon and for the 4
 5 benefit of each and every tract of unitized land, and no lease shall be deemed 5
 6 to expire by reason of failure to drill or produce wells situated on the land 6
 7 therein embraced. 7

8 (c) Suspension of drilling or producing operations on all unitized lands 8
 9 pursuant to direction or consent of the Secretary or his duly authorized representa- 9
 10 tive shall be deemed to constitute such suspension pursuant to such direction or 10
 11 consent as to each and every tract of unitized land. 11

12 (d) Each lease, sublease or contract relating to the exploration, drilling, 12
 13 development or operation for oil or gas of lands other than those of the United 13
 14 States committed to this agreement, which, by its terms might expire prior to the 14
 15 termination of this agreement, is hereby extended beyond any such term so pro- 15
 16 vided therein so that it shall be continued in full force and effect for and 16
 17 during the term of this agreement. 17

18 (e) Any Federal lease for a fixed term of twenty (20) years or any re- 18
 19 newal thereof or any part of such lease which is made subject to this agreement 19
 20 shall continue in force beyond the term provided therein until the termination 20
 21 hereof. Any other Federal lease committed hereto shall continue in force beyond 21
 22 the term so provided therein or by law as to the land committed so long as such 22
 23 lease remains subject hereto, provided that production is had in paying quantities 23
 24 under this unit agreement prior to the expiration date of the term of such lease, 24
 25 or in the event actual drilling operations are commenced on unitized land, in 25
 26 accordance with the provisions of this agreement, prior to the end of the primary 26
 27 term of such lease and are being diligently prosecuted at that time, such lease 27
 28 shall be extended for two years and so long thereafter as oil or gas is produced 28
 29 in paying quantities in accordance with the provisions of the Mineral Leasing Act 29
 30 Revision of 1960. 30

31 (f) Each sublease or contract relating to the operation and development 31
 32 of unitized substances from lands of the United States committed to this agreement, 32
 33 which by its terms would expire prior to the time at which the underlying lease, 33
 34 as extended by the immediately preceding paragraph, will expire, is hereby extended 34
