5 (k) If all or any part of the unit area lies within a municipal water-shed, or 5  
 6 are, in the opinion of the authorized representative of the Secretary of 6  
 7 Agriculture, primarily valuable for water-shed protection, the unit operator 7  
 8 shall reseed or otherwise restore the vegetative cover, as required by the 8  
 9 authorized representative of the Secretary of Agriculture, for water-shed 9  
 10 protection and erosion prevention on any areas damaged because of the 10  
 11 operation. 11

12 34. FOREST LAND STIPULATION (Form 4-216(a)). The lands embraced in this unit 12  
 13 being within the area designated in the memorandum of August 15, 1947, by the 13  
 14 Secretary of the Interior ("Oil and Gas Leases in the Jackson Hole, Wyoming area;" 14  
 15 Federal Register, August 30, 1947, page 5859), which specifies the general conditions 15  
 16 under which the unitized development of the oil and gas resources is authorized, the 16  
 17 unit operator hereby agrees: 17

18 (a) To drill only such wells on the unit land as may be authorized by the 18  
 19 Secretary of the Interior under an approved unit plan; to drill no well 19  
 20 within 1250 feet of any public road on or adjacent to the leased land without 20  
 21 the consent of the Secretary of the Interior first had and obtained; to re- 21  
 22 frain from defacing, injuring, or destroying trees, shrubs, or natural 22  
 23 features, or removing same outside of the authorized work limits or pipe 23  
 24 line and road rights of way as established pursuant to or revised in accord- 24  
 25 ance with, the unit plan. After designation of the authorized work limits 25  
 26 by the Secretary or his representatives, unit operator shall mark such limits 26  
 27 by some acceptable visual means. The location of camps, storage, parking 27  
 28 of equipment, and storage of materials shall be confined within the authorized 28  
 29 work limits. Sludge or other waste by-products from drilling or operations 29  
 30 shall be so confined or disposed of that they do not destroy scenic or wild- 30  
 31 life values or pollute streams. 31

32 (b) To remove at the termination of drilling operations, all camps and buildings 32  
 33 not essential to a continuing operation of any well, and to fill all sump 33  
 34 holes, ditches and other excavations, remove or cover all debris, and to 34
