KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That:

For and in consideration of the Sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, Continental Oil Company, a Delaware corporation, does hereby give, grant, assign, transfer and convey unto El Paso Natural Gas Company, a Delaware corporation, and its personal representatives, successors and assigns, to have and to hold forever all of assignors interest in the following described oil and gas lease insofar only as the following specifically described lands are covered thereby:
