

S T I P U L A T I O N

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS, under date of February 21, 1964, Chandler-Simpson, Inc., by instrument recorded in Book 39 at page 61 of the Records of the County Clerk and Recorder, Sublette County, Wyoming, assigned an overriding royalty interest to Robert E. Park in the following described oil and gas leases and the leasehold estates created thereby covering lands in Sublette County, Wyoming:

On the date of the aforementioned overriding royalty assignment Chandler-Simpson, Inc. was the owner of an undivided 50% working interest, subject to its proportionate part of the burden of a 2-1/2% overriding royalty interest, and it was the intent of the parties that by virtue of such overriding royalty assignment Chandler-Simpson, Inc. assign
