

1 33. STATE LAND PROVISIONS. Certain of the unitized lands are public lands
2 of the State of Wyoming, and in connection with the approval of this agreement
3 by the Board of Land Commissioners of said state pursuant to Sec. 36-74,
4 Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as amended together with the relating Federal regula-
5 tions, it is agreed that there shall be filed with the Commissioner of Public
6 Lands of said state:

7 (a) Two copies of the complete Unit Agreement and two copies of any
8 revised Exhibits "A" and "B" concurrently with the filing thereof with
9 the Supervisor, pursuant to Section 2 hereof.

10 (b) Two copies of any notice of the proposed expansion or contraction of
11 the unit area required to be delivered to the Supervisor pursuant to
12 Section 2 (b) hereof.

13 (c) Two copies of any unit operating agreement executed pursuant to
14 Section 7 hereof.

15 (d) A copy of any schedule of proposed participating area submitted for
16 approval under Section 11, concurrently with its submission to the
17 Director. The Commissioner, or his authorized representative, shall have
18 a period of fifteen (15) days from receipt of said schedule within which
19 to file with the Supervisor any objection thereto, together with any
20 recommendation for revision thereof. If such objection or recommendation
21 is not concurred in by Unit Operator and Supervisor prior to submission
22 of the schedule to the Director for approval, the Director shall approve
23 or disapprove the schedule after giving due consideration to the objections
24 and recommendations filed by the Commissioner or his representative.

25 (e) A copy of any proposed Plan of Development or modification thereof,
26 which is filed with the Supervisor under Section 10 hereof.

27 (f) A copy of all instruments of subsequent joinder executed under
28 Section 28 hereof.

29 It is agreed further that:

30 (1) All valid, pertinent and reasonable regulations hereafter issued
31 governing drilling and producing operations on non-Federal lands which
32 are not inconsistent with the terms hereof or the laws of the State of
33 Wyoming are hereby accepted and made a part of this agreement.

34 (2) Nothing in this agreement contained shall relieve lessees of the
35 public lands of the State of Wyoming from their obligation to pay rentals,
36 and royalties with respect to unitized substances allocated to such lands
37 hereunder, at the rates specified in their respective leases.

38 (3) In the event that a title dispute arises as to State lands or leases,
39 no payments of funds due the State of Wyoming should be withheld, but
40 such funds shall be deposited as directed by the Commissioner of Public
41 Lands to be held as unearned money pending final settlement of the title
42 dispute, and then applied as earned or returned in accordance with such
43 final settlement.

44 Each party to this agreement, holding any lease or leases of public lands
45 from the State of Wyoming subject to this agreement, or holding any interest
46 in or under such lease or leases or in the production from the lands covered
47 thereby, agrees that said Board of Land Commissioners may, and by its approval
48 hereof, does hereby alter, change, modify, or revoke the drilling, producing
49 and royalty requirements of such lease or leases, and the regulations in
50 respect thereto, to conform the provisions of said lease or leases to the
51 provisions of this agreement. Such parties and said Board further agree that,
52 except as otherwise expressly provided in this agreement, no such lease shall
53 be deemed to terminate or expire so long as it shall remain committed hereto.
54 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Section 19 hereof contained,
55 should any of the public lands of the State of Wyoming outside of a partici-
56 pating area established hereunder cease to be committed to this agreement,
57 such lands shall thereafter be free from the effect of this agreement unless
58 and until such lands are expressly recommitted to this agreement pursuant to
59 Section 28 hereof, with the approval of the Board of Land Commissioners.
