In the event assignee herein shall desire to surrender said lease as to all or any part of the acreage covered hereby, assignee agrees to notify assignor at least 90 days in advance of the anniversary date specified in said lease, and assignor hereunder shall then have 15 days after receipt of such notice within which to elect to take a reassignment of said lease as to the portion thereof to be relinquished. Should assignor hereunder elect to receive such a reassignment, same must be delivered by assignee, 60 days in advance of such anniversary date.
