Township 33 North, Range 109 West, 6th P. M.

Section 23: That portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying and being situate North of U. S. Highway 187, less a tract of 73.81 acres, more or less, in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of the said Section 23 where is found a blue granite stone 7"x5"x6" above ground marked - on E and = on S with pits in each Section and mound of earth; thence South 89 degrees 59 minutes West, 660.0 feet along the south line of said Section 23 to a point; thence North 36 degrees 07 minutes West, 1113.1 feet to a point on the west line of the said E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence North 00 degrees 04 minutes East, 1765.0 feet along the said west line to the northwest corner of the said E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South 89 degrees 59 minutes East, 1318.7 feet along the North line of the said E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ to the east one-quarter corner of said Section 23 which is described on the map for the South Bend Road of record in the office of the Clerk of Sublette County; thence South 00 degrees 06 minutes West, 2663.1 feet along the east line of said Section 23 to the point of beginning, each point being marked by a steel T-shaped stake 24" long with brass cap inscribed "Survey Point Do Not Disturb RLS 164".

Section 26: NE $\frac{1}{4}$, less a tract therein described as follows: Beginning at a point 100 feet east of the SW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence West 100 feet along the quarter Section line; thence 100 feet North along the quarter Section line; thence southeasterly to the point of beginning.
