

STIPULATION

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, T36N R109W., 6th PM, Wyoming, is within the Willow Creek Guard Station Administrative Site which has been developed and is being used by the Forest Service. No occupancy of the surface of this area is authorized by this lease. The lessee is, however, authorized to employ directional drilling to exploit the mineral resources under this area provided that such drilling will not disturb the surface of the area or otherwise interfere with the use being made of it by the Forest Service and the public. It is understood and agreed that the use of this area for national forest purposes is superior to any other use.
