AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 24th day of September, 19 69

hereinafter called lessor (whether one or more) and

WITNESSETH, That the said lessor, for and in consideration of ten and more Dollars (\$10.00+) cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of lessee to be paid, kept and performed, has granted, demised, leased, and let and by these presents does grant, demise, lease and let unto the said lessee, its successors and assigns for the sole and only purposes of surveying by geological, geophysical and all other methods, mining and operating for oil and gas, and laying pipe lines, and building tanks, power stations and structures thereon to produce, save and take care of said products, all that certain tract of land, together with any reversionary rights therein, situate in the County of Sublette State of Wyoming, described as follows, to wit:

Part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 37 North, Range 113 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Sublette County, Wyoming, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on the west line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 23 at a point located North 0° 56' East, 1747.58 feet from the south quarter-section corner of said Section 23; running thence South 74° 48' East, 839.04 feet; thence North 15° 12' East, 250.11 feet; thence North 74° 48' West, 902.64 feet to the west line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South 0° 56' West, 258.07 feet to the point of beginning, and all corners of said parcel being marked by a 3/4" steel T-bar driven in the ground topped with a steel identification cap inscribed "RLS 641."
