

1 (1) To conduct all operations authorized by this unit with. 1
2 due regard for good land management, not to cut or destroy. 2
3 timber without first obtaining permission from the authorized 3
4 representative of the Secretary of Agriculture, and to pay for 4
5 all such timber cut or destroyed at the rates prescribed by 5
6 such representative; to avoid unnecessary damage to improve- 6
7 ments, timber, crops, or other cover; unless otherwise author- 7
8 ized by the Secretary of Agriculture, not to drill any well, 8
9 carry on operations, make excavations, construct tunnels, drill, 9
10 or otherwise disturb the surface of the lands within 200 feet of 10
11 any building standing on the lands and whenever required, in 11
12 writing, by the authorized representative of the Secretary of 12
13 Agriculture to fence or fill all sump holes, ditches, and other 13
14 excavations, remove or cover all debris, and so far as reason- 14
15 ably possible, restore the surface of the lands to their former 15
16 condition, including the removal of structures as and if re- 16
17 quired, and when required by such representative to bury all 17
18 pipelines below plow depth. 18
19 (2) To do all in its power to prevent and suppress forest, 19
20 brush, or grass fires on the lands and in their vicinity, 20
21 and to require its employees, contractors, subcontractors, 21
22 and employees of contractors or subcontractors to do likewise. 22
23 Unless prevented by circumstances over which it has no control, 23
24 the Unit Operator shall place its employees, contractors, sub- 24
25 contractors, and employees of contractors and subcontractors 25
26 employed on the lands at the disposal of any authorized officer 26
27 of the Department of Agriculture for the purpose of fighting 27
28 forest, brush, or grass fires on or originating on the lands 28
29 or on adjacent areas or caused by the negligence of the Unit 29
30 Operator or its employees, contractors, subcontractors and 30
31 employees of contractors and subcontractors, with the under- 31
32 standing that payment for such services shall be made at rates 32
33 to be determined by the authorized representative of the 33
34 Secretary of Agriculture, which rates shall not be less than 34
