the said oil, gas and other hydrocarbon substances so produced and saved from said land to be delivered free of cost to Assignee, his successors or assigns, in the pipe line or pipe lines serving said premises or into tanks erected for the purpose of storing said products, together with the rights, privileges and benefits derived therefrom. Assignor covenants and agrees that she has lawful right to sell and convey said royalty, and that she will warrant and defend the title to the same, but only against her lawful acts.

The Assignor hereby reserves the right (and the same is agreed to by Assignee) to sell and dispose of the royalty oil and gas to the purchaser or purchasers of Assignor's own oil and gas, subject to proper accounting and payment to Assignee, his successors and assigns.

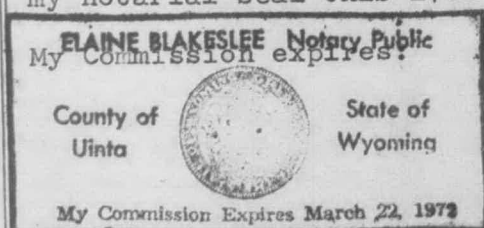
