NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the above named claimant the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said lands with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant, his successors and assigns, forever;
