1. Those rights for electric power line purposes as have been granted to Lincoln Service Corporation, its successors or assigns by permit Wyoming 0313787 under the Act of February 15, 1901, 31 Stat. 790, as amended, 43 U.S.C. 959; and .
2. A reservation to the general public of a right-of-way 100 feet wide, for public access and utilities, along the entire north and west boundary of the land.
