Reserving, also, to the United States, all coal in the land so granted and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove coal from the same upon compliance with the conditions and subject to the limitations of the Act of June 22, 1910 (36 Stat. 583).

Excepting and reserving, also, to the United States all the oil and gas in the land so patented, and to it or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove such deposits from the same upon compliance with the conditions and subject to the provisions and limitations of the Act of July 17, 1914 (38 Stat. 509).

This entry is made under Section 29 of the Act of February 25, 1920 (41 Stat. 437) and the Act of March 4, 1933 (47 Stat. 1570), and the patent is issued subject to the rights of prior permittees or lessees to use so much of the surface of said land as is required for mining operations, without compensation to the patentee for damages resulting from proper mining operations.
