

SUBJECT TO:

1. A highway right-of-way appropriated August 12, 1935, for the Wyoming State Highway Department by Sublette County pursuant to R.S. 2477 (formerly 43 U.S.C. 932) for U.S. Highway 189, limited to 75 feet on either side of the centerline of the road in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ section 14, and of record in the Bureau of Land Management's Wyoming State Office under Serial No. W-88026;
2. Those rights for a county road right-of-way appropriated by Sublette County under authority of R.S. 2477 (formerly 43 U.S.C. 932), of record in the Bureau of Land Management, Rock Springs District Office, under Serial No. W-76118;
3. Those rights for a ditch right-of-way as have been granted to Thomas S. Harrower, his successors or assigns, by Permit No. Wyoming 010870 under the Act of March 3, 1891, 26 Stat. 1101 (formerly 43 U.S.C. 946); and
4. Those rights for electric distribution line purposes as have been granted to Utah Power and Light Company, its successors or assigns, by Permit No. Wyoming 036810 under the Act of February 15, 1901, 31 Stat. 790 (formerly 43 U.S.C. 959).
