

- same under applicable law and such regulations as the Secretary of the Interior may prescribe. This includes all necessary and incidental activities conducted in accordance with the provisions of the mining, geothermal and mineral leasing, and material disposal laws in effect at the time such activities are undertaken, including, without limitation, necessary access and exit rights, all drilling, underground, open pit or surface mining operations, storage and transportation facilities deemed necessary and authorized under law and implementing regulations;
3. The right of the United States, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration, its successors and assigns, to prevent any use of the above described real property which would interfere with landing and taking off of aircraft at the Big Piney Municipal Airport or otherwise constitute an airport hazard. The United States, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration, reserves the right to enter upon the land, and to remove the offending structure or object, and to cut the offending overgrowth, all at the expense of the property owner, in the event the aforesaid reservation is breached; and

SUBJECT TO:

1. The provisions of the Federal Aviation Administration's February 24, 1989, determination, as it affects areas specifically described as "A", "B", "C", and "D", located north of Sublette County Road No. 23-143, as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and by reference hereby incorporated in and made part of this conveyance. The provisions are as follows:
