QUITCLAIM DEED

Beginning at the West quarter corner of Section 14, Township 32 North, Range 107 West, and proceeding thence northerly along the West line of said Section 14 a distance of 300 feet; thence proceeding easterly at right angles to the West line of said Section 14 a distance of 300 feet; thence proceeding southerly parallel to the West line of said Section 14 a distance of 300 feet; thence proceeding westerly at right angles to the West line of said Section 14 a distance of 300 feet, more or less, to the West quarter corner of Section 14, Township 32 North, Range 107 West, which point is the point of beginning of this traverse.
