KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That John Vible and Louise Vible, his wife

the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, has remised, released, and forever quitclaimed
 and by these presents do for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators,
 remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Frederick G. Petersen, Michael R. Nystrom
Vernon T. Delgado, James P. Petersen, Kent Snidecor, and John A. Nystrom, Jr., their

heirs and assigns, forever, all such right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand, as
 they have or ought to have, in or to all the following described premises, to-wit:

Township 33 North, Range 107 West, 6th P.M., Wyoming

Section 23: W₂SE₁SE₄, E₂SW₂SE₄, SE₂NW₂SE₄, S₂SW₂NE₄NW₂SE₄

Subject to easements and rights of way of record or in use.

Note: The sole purpose of this Quitclaim Deed is to terminate that lease, insofar as the same affects the above described lands, with Edd T. Pennock and Nettie Pennock, his wife and Charles R. Pennock, a single man, as grantors to John Vible, as grantee, dated April 25, 1949 and filed for record in the office of the County Clerk, Sublette County, Wyoming October 12, 1954 and recorded in Book 14 of Miscellaneous, on page 257.

Hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Wyoming.

Nystrom, Jr. their heirs and assigns, to his and their own proper use and behoof forever. So that neither John Vible and Louise Vible, his wife nor any other person in their name or behalf, or either of us or any other person in our or either of our names or behalf shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the premises or any part thereof, but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
