Section 2: SE $\frac{1}{4}$

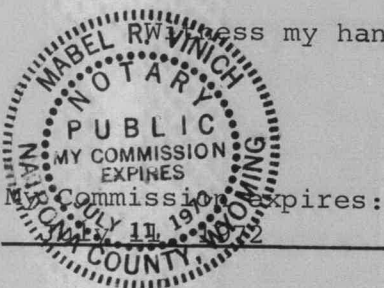
Hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption laws of the State of Wyoming.
