KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That WYOMING TELEPHONE COMPANY, INCORPORATED, a Wyoming corporation, grantor, for and in consideration of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations, CONVEYS AND QUILTS CLAIM unto GORDON E. STEELE and DONNA M. STEELE, husband and wife, and to the survivor thereof as tenants by the entireties and not as tenants in common, grantees, of Sublette County and State of Wyoming, all interest in the following described real estate situate in the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming, to-wit:

That certain parcel and tract of land bounded and contained within the following traverse, to-wit: Beginning at a point which bears South 55° 30' West a distance of 2089 feet from the Northeast corner of Section 16, Township 32 North, Range 108 West of the 6th P.M., and proceeding therefrom North 39° 50' West a distance of 143.50 feet to a point which said point is the initial or descriptive point of the following traverse:

From said initial point thence proceed North 39° 50' East a distance of 75 feet to a point;

Thence proceed North 50° 10' West a distance of 50 feet to a point;

Thence proceed South 39° 50' West a distance of 75 feet to a point;

Thence proceed South 50° 10' East to the aforesaid point of beginning.
