

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County, Wyoming, deem the public interest requires that a road be established to be known as the New Fork Bridge Road No. 23-175. Described as follows:

Beginning at station 0+00 on the south right-of-way line of U. S. Secondary Highway 1801 in Lot 7, Section 15, T30N, R110W, N88degrees-36'W, 129 feet from the NE corner of Lot 7, Section 15, T30N, R110W.

And thence running Southerly through the following:

T30N R110W

Section 15 - Lots 7 and 8

Section 22 - Lots 2 and 8, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 23 - Lots 1 and 2, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 27 - N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Lot 3, and W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

And terminating at station 168+011 on the west line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T30N, R110W, N00degrees-13'W, 713.2 feet from the SW corner of Section 27, T30N, R110W.

WHEREAS, right-of-way easements have been secured from Peter S. and Anne Olson, Marincic Land and Livestock Company, and the State of Wyoming as owners of the only patented lands.

WHEREAS, an affidavit for right-of-way has been filed and granted by the Land Office in Cheyenne, Wyoming for all Federally owned lands.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the New Fork Bridge Road No. 23-175 as described above, be and it hereby is declared established as a public road.
