

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County, Wyoming, deem the public interest requires that a road be established to be known as the Steele Lane County Road No. 23-155 described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, T32N, R107W, on the south right-of-way line of State Secondary 1804, at station 0+00, S86°-31'E, a distance of 73 feet from the NW corner of Section 18, T32N, R107W.

Thence running Southerly through the following

T32N R107W

Section 18 - W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Thence Southwesterly through the following:

- T32N R108W

Section 13 - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 24 - W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

And terminating at a point S54°-18'W, a distance of 2377.3 feet from the NE corner of Section 24, T32N, R108W.

WHEREAS, right-of-way easements have been secured from Ralph Allen Steele and Irene J. Steele, husband and wife, Nellie F. Steele, a widow, Ted L. Steele, Wayne F. Steele, Floyd E. Bousman and Margaret J. Bousman, husband and wife, and the State of Wyoming.

WHEREAS, there are no federally owned lands.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Steele Lane County Road No. 23-155 as described above, be and it hereby is declared established as a public road.
