

RESOLUTION NO. 83-49B

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND APPROVING THE APPLICATION AS AMENDED OF THE SUBLETTE COUNTY PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION TO AMEND THE ZONING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS RESOLUTION OF SUBLETTE COUNTY, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, the Sublette County Planning and Zoning Commission filed an application to amend the Zoning and Development Regulations Resolution of Sublette County;

WHEREAS, a notice of public hearing on said application before said Commission was published in the Pinedale Roundup on April 14 and May 12, 1983;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said published notice, a public hearing on said application was had before said Planning and Zoning Commission at 7:30 p.m. on May 19, 1983, at which time said Commission determined that it would recommend to the Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County that the proposed amendments for Chapters I, II, III, IV, and VII, as amended at said public hearing be approved;

WHEREAS, a notice of public hearing on said amended application before the Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County was published in the Pinedale Roundup on July 14 and August 11, 1983;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said published notice, a public hearing on said amended application was had before said Board of County Commissioners at 1:00 p.m. on August 16, 1983, at which time said Planning and Zoning Commission and approve the following amendments of the Zoning and Development Regulations Resolution of Sublette County:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUBLETTE COUNTY:

SECTION 1. That the Zoning and Development Regulations, as adopted on December 13, 1978, and amended on March 10, 1981 and June 1, 1982, is hereby further amended in the following particulars:

CHAPTER I

Section 6. Definitions. ADD THE FOLLOWING:

e. AUM: 1 AUM (Animal Unit Month) equals the following:

- 1 horse or cow
- 4 calves
- 2 colts
- 2½ sows or boars
- 5 market pigs
- 7 ewes or bucks
- 14 lambs
- 100 poultry

y. Home Business: An occupation or activity operated on the premises by the immediate family members and not more than one other employee. An accessory building is allowed and must be authorized or constructed under proper permit unless prohibited by restrictive covenants.
