

## R E S O L U T I O N    N O.    84-111B

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNTY ASSESSOR TO CONTINUE TO ASSESS PROPERTY, EXCEPT MINERALS, AT THE RATE OF 8% OF CURRENT MARKET VALUE FOR 1985 AND SUBSEQUENT YEARS, AND TO NOTIFY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND TAXATION THAT THE BOARD OPPOSES SAID DEPARTMENT'S INTENTION TO ADOPT A RULE ESTABLISHING THE PERCENTAGE FACTOR AT TEN PERCENT.

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County, Wyoming, held on December 4, 1984, it was unanimously determined and resolved that the board approved the intention of the County Assessor to assess property, except minerals, at the rate of 8% of current market value for 1985, and to notify the State Department of Revenue and Taxation that it opposes said department's intention to adopt a rule establishing a percentage factor of 10%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUBLETTE COUNTY, WYOMING:

Section 1. That the board approves the intention of the Sublette County Assessor to assess property, except minerals, at the rate of 8% of current market value for 1985.

Section 2. That the board opposes the intention of the State of Wyoming Department of Revenue and Taxation to establish a percentage factor of 10% for 1985 and subsequent years.

Section 3. That a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to Warren Bower, Director, Ad Valorem Division, for submission to and consideration by the Department of Revenue and Taxation at said department's meeting on December 20 and 21, 1984, at the Herschler Office Building, in Cheyenne, Wyoming.
