

RESOLUTION NO. 85-71

A RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING ADOPTION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A COUNTY COURT SYSTEM FOR SUBLINTE COUNTY, WYOMING, AND CLARIFYING ITS EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners held on December 4, 1984, it was unanimously determined and resolved that Sublette County establish a county court system for the county, to become operational on the earliest date that state financing becomes available.

WHEREAS, under letter dated January 9, 1985, Richard V. Thomas, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Wyoming notified the board that said resolution appeared to equivocate as to the date of the establishment of said county court system.

WHEREAS, it is the intention and desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County, Wyoming, to reaffirm the adoption and establishment of a county court system, and to eliminate the objection voiced by Chief Justice Thomas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUBLINTE COUNTY, WYOMING:

1. That the terms of Resolution No. 84-109B, in so far as the same are not in conflict with the terms of this resolution are hereby ratified, adopted and confirmed, namely, that there is hereby declared to be established and adopted a county court system for Sublette County, Wyoming, consisting of one county judge sitting in Pinedale, and in the Big Piney-Marbleton area as required.

2. That the county court system for this county shall become effective and operational on July 1, 1985.

3. That funding for the operation and maintenance of the county court system shall be as provided by statute.

4. That the court shall be called the "County Court of Sublette County, Wyoming."

5. That the justice of the peace courts of Sublette County shall be supplanted and replaced by the county court system on July 1, 1985.
