

R E S O L U T I O N N O. 85-17J

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS 84-109B AND 85-7J PERTAINING TO ESTABLISHMENT OF COUNTY COURT SYSTEM, AND ADOPTING A COUNTY COURT SYSTEM EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1986, IF FUNDED BY THE STATE.

WHEREAS, on February 5, 1985, Resolution 85-7J was adopted, which modified Resolution 84-109B which had been adopted on December 4, 1984, to clarify the method of funding and to establish an effective date of July 1, 1985.

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the board held on April 16, 1985, it was unanimously decided that both said resolutions should be rescinded, and that a county court system should be adopted with an effective date of July 1, 1986, provided that the state would fund such system in accordance with existing law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUBLETTE COUNTY, WYOMING:

1. That Resolutions 84-109B and 85-7J are hereby rescinded in their entireties.
2. That the board hereby declares and adopts the establishment of a county court system for Sublette County, Wyoming, consisting of one county judge sitting in Pinedale, and providing services to the Big Piney-Marbleton area, as required.
3. That the county court system for this county shall become effective and operational on July 1, 1986.
4. That funding for the operation and maintenance of the county court system shall be as provided by statute.
5. That the court shall be called the "County Court of Sublette County, Wyoming."
6. That the justice of the peace courts of Sublette County shall be supplanted and replaced by the county court system on July 1, 1986.
