

RESOLUTION NO. 86-86J

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND APPROVING THE APPLICATION BY TOM JACKSON FOR A ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY CHANGE TO RECLASSIFY AND REZONE 6.8 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, FROM A-1 DISTRICT TO R-R 5 DISTRICT BEING PART OF SECTION 19 AND SECTION 30, T37N, R112W, SUBLINTE COUNTY, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, Tom Jackson filed application with the Sublette County Planning and Zoning Commission to reclassify and rezone 6.808 acres from A-1 district to R-R 5 district being part of Lot 4, Section 19 and Lot 1, Section 30, T37N, R112W;

WHEREAS, a notice of public hearing on said application before said Commission was published in the Pinedale Roundup on April 10 and May 8, 1986;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said published notice, a public hearing on said application was had before the said Planning and Zoning Commission at 7:30 p.m. on May 15, 1986, at which time said Commission determined it would recommend to the Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County that the application be approved;

WHEREAS, a notice of public hearing on said application before the Board of County Commissioners of Sublette County was published in the Pinedale Roundup on June 12, 1986;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said published notice, a public hearing on said application was had before said Board of County Commissioners at 1:00 p.m. on July 1, 1986, at which time said Board determined it would accept the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission and approve said application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the application by Tom Jackson for a zoning district boundary change from A-1 district to R-R 5 district for 6.808 acres being part of Lot 4, Section 19 and Lot 1, Section 30, T37N, R112W, Sublette County, Wyoming, is hereby approved.
