Section 20 -- NW1/4NE1/4

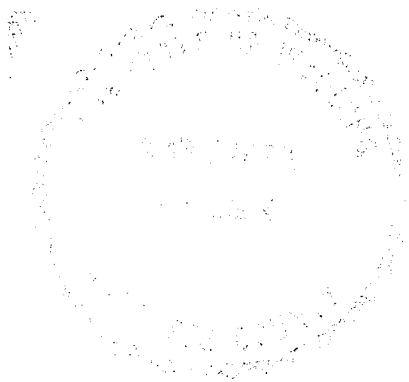
Section 17 -- SW1/4NE1/4

WHEREAS, the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 21 October 1976 requires the obtaining of a right-of-way across these lands from the Bureau of Land Management;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to apply for a right-of-way from the Bureau across the aforesaid lands in the name of the COUNTY OF SUBLETTE; and

FURTHER, that the Chairman of the Board, Gordon Johnston or his successor, be authorized to sign the application in the name of the Board and the County.
