Clarkson has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from South Beaver Creek tributary of Green River through the Clarkson No. 1 Ditch, under Permit No. 13951 for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Sublette County, Wyoming, and for domestic purposes.

NOW, KNOW YE, That the Board of Control, under the provisions of Chapter 65 + 68, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1920, has, by an order duly made and entered on the 17th day of April A.
