CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

WHEREAS, Pinedale Power and Light Company has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from Pine Creek tributary of West Fork of New Fork River, trib. New Fork River through the East T. L. L. Ditch under Permit No. 4430 for generation of power irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Sublette County, Wyoming,

NOW KNOW YE, That the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapter 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899 has, by an order duly made and entered on the 10th day of November A. D. 1928, in Order Record No. 9, Page 712, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:

Name of Appropriator Pinedale Power and Light Company, Postoffice Address Pinedale, Wyoming;
 Amount of Appropriation 31.25 cu. ft. per sec.; Date of Appropriation December 10, 1924; Description of land to be irrigated and for which this appropriation is determined and established; Total Acreage.

This appropriation to be used for the generation of power by the Pinedale Power and Light Company, in an amount not to exceed 31.25 cubic feet per second of time with point of use located in the sw 4th ne 4th of section 27, Township 34 North, Range 109 West.

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to generation of power and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.

This appropriation to be used for the generation of power by the Pinedale Power and Light Company, in an amount not to exceed 22.5 cubic feet per second of time with point of use located in the sw 1/4 ne 1/4 of section 27, Township 34 North Range 109 West.

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to generation of power and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.
