NOW, KNOW YE, That the Board of Control, under the provisions of Chapter 132, Wyoming Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1931, has, by an order duly made and entered on the 8th day of March A. D. 1943, in Order Record No. 10, Page 591, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:
