WHEREAS, United States of America, Forest Service has presented to the Board of Control of the State of Wyoming proof of the appropriation of water from Franklin Spring, tributary of Middle Piney Creek, through the middle Piney Ditches, Homestead Ditch, under Permit No. 195701, for irrigation of the lands herein described, lying and being in Sublette County, Wyoming,

NOW, KNOW YE, That the Board of Control, under the provisions of Division 1, Title 9, Chapters 10 and 14 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1899, has, by an order duly made and entered on the 8th day of March A. D. 1924, in Order Record No. 10, Page 591, determined and established the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:
