The total amount of water that may be used under the combined appropriations shall be the minimum amount required for the irrigation of said lands and shall not exceed the statutory limit of one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres irrigated

The right to water hereby confirmed and established is limited to irrigation stock and domestic use and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed one cubic foot per second for each seventy acres of land for which appropriation is herein determined and established.
